Purpose:

Introduction:

Marketing and Communications Information, which includes your preferences in respect of receiving marketing information from us and our third parties, and your communication preferences.

How We Use Your Information:

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- Provide services or products you request (e.g. send you by email or other electronic means or other products or services in which you express an interest);
- To conduct credit reference checks and assessments;
- Inform you of changes made to our Website;
- Develop a more direct relationship with you for the purposes described in this section;
- Understand general customer trends and patterns so we can develop and support existing and ongoing marketing strategies for our products and services;
- For security, administrative and legal purposes.
- To process payments and fulfil orders.
- To comply with legal obligations.

Sharing Your Information:

We may share your information in the following circumstances:

- We will not intentionally disclose your Personal Information, whether for commercial gain or otherwise, other than with your permission or in the manner as set out in this Privacy Policy.
 ProFloat may share your Personal Information under the following circumstances:
- with other entities within ProFloat(including those based overseas) that have agreed to be bound by this Privacy Policy. To the extent legally permissible and in accordance with the conditions of this Privacy Policy, we may share your Personal Data with any successor entity.
- with our agents, advisers, service providers and suppliers that have agreed to be bound by this Privacy Policy or similar terms, which offer the same level as protection as this Privacy Policy;
- with our employees, suppliers, service providers and agents to the extent that they require such Personal
 Information in the provision of services for or to us, which include hosting, development and administration,
 technical support and other support services relating to the Website or the operation of the ProFloat business.
 We will authorise any Personal Information processing done by a third party on our behalf, amongst other
 things by entering into written agreements with those third parties governing our relationship with them and
 containing confidentiality and non-disclosure provisions;
- to enable us to enforce or apply any other contract between you and us;
- to protect our rights, property or safety or that of our customers, employees, contractors, suppliers, service providers, agents, brokers and any other third party;
- to mitigate any actual or reasonably perceived risk to us, our customers, employees, contractors, agents, brokers or any other third party;
- with entities that are based overseas ("Overseas Recipients"). ProFloat cannot guarantee that any such
 Overseas Recipients will comply fully with the ProFloat's privacy principles in relation to your Personal Data.
 Notwithstanding the a foregoing, ProFloat undertakes to take all reasonable steps to ensure that any such

By continuing to use the Website, you acknowledge and consent in respect of the aforementioned transfer of your Personal Data to any such Overseas Recipients on these terms as permitted by the ProFloat privacy principles and agree not to hold ProFloat liable in this regard.

- with governmental agencies, exchanges and other regulatory or self-regulatory bodies, if required to do so by law or there is a reasonable belief that such is necessary for:
 - o compliance with the law or with any legal process;
 - the protection and defence of the rights, property or safety of ProFloat, or our customers, employees, contractors, suppliers, service providers, agents, brokers or any third party;
 - the detection, prevention and management of actual or alleged fraud, security breaches, technical issues, or the abuse, misuse or unauthorised use of the Website and contraventions of this Privacy Policy;
 - the protection of the rights, property or safety of members of the public (if you provide false or deceptive information or misrepresent yourself, we may proactively disclose such information to the appropriate regulatory bodies and/or commercial entities).

Security of Your Information

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your information from unauthorized access, use, alteration, or destruction.

Your Choices and Rights

- Request the deletion of your information, subject to legal requirements.
- Withdraw consent previously given in respect of the processing of your Personal Information at any time which
 withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out prior to your notice of
 withdrawal.
